

Instructions For Completion of the World Cup 2026 Entry Form

- 1) The spreadsheet has a series of yellow boxes awaiting your score predictions. Your job is get your spreadsheet back to me completed with your score predictions of **all 104 matches before 11 June** before the commencement of the summer's great Soccer-ball fest on 11 June.
- 2) We are looking for score predictions at the **end of open play** in any match.
- 3) The spreadsheet has a horrible drop-down selection option for score entry but you can also just type your numbers in.
- 4) For the Group Stage it's all very straightforward – just put your win, lose or draw score predictions for every match in columns F and G.
- 5) The spreadsheet will automatically generate the fixtures for the Round of 32, and again you should make your predictions for all these matches now. However this is where it can get a bit tricky so please see the guidance below:

Use this column to enter penalty results only in the case of a draw prediction. **It has no bearing at all on our game** but merely forces through to the next round the team you think will win, for you to predict against in the next round.

- 6) Complete subsequent rounds in the same way right through to the bitter end.
- 7) Save your completed spreadsheet file and send it back to me at football@whitewey.co.uk or andrew.burgess@scitech.com.
- 8) When the matches take place points will be awarded for accuracy of predictions based on the trusty formula as outlined here: [Scoring System](#)
- 9) Once things start everyone's predictions will be posted up on the website (whitewey.co.uk) and a daily league table maintained so you can track your progress or otherwise.
- 10) **Important note:** As the protagonists in the later round fixtures become known you may want to change your score predictions! This is allowed – just make sure you get your new prediction set in to me ahead of any match taking place. This might be a bit messy as FIFA in their wisdom are running things fine between the end of the Group Stage and the start of the Round of 32. I may or may not send a reminder, but essentially if you want to change predictions **it is your responsibility to get your new score predictions back to me before any matches take place!**
- 11) **Also note:** If you leave your later round predicted scores as originally submitted they will be “inherited” by the teams really taking part so you’ll still score points accordingly in the competition. Probably more in fact.
